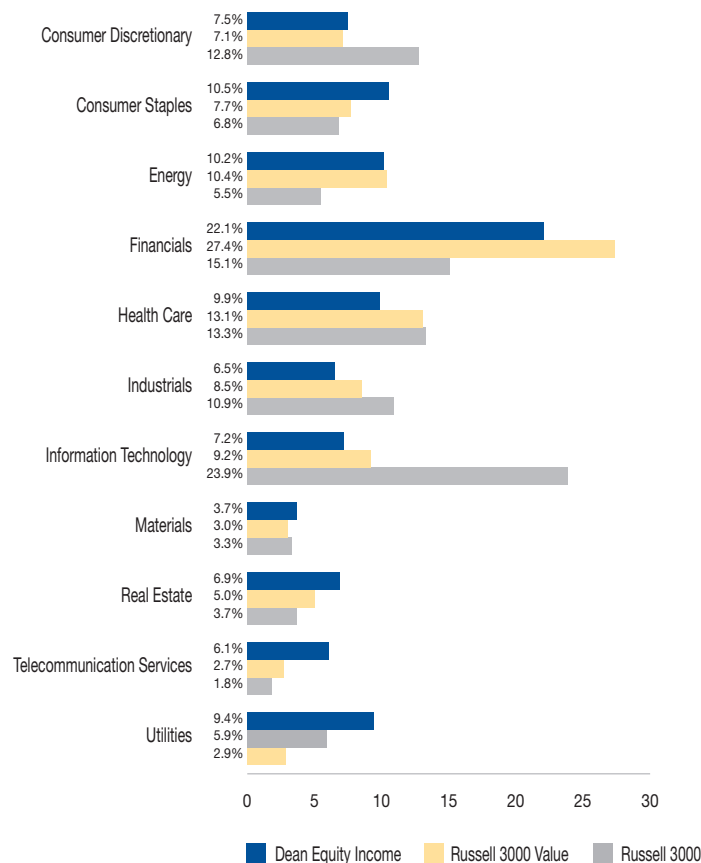

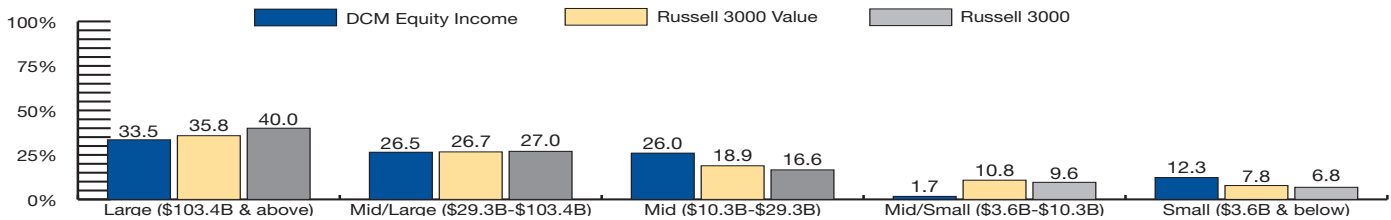

Market Capitalization^{2,4}

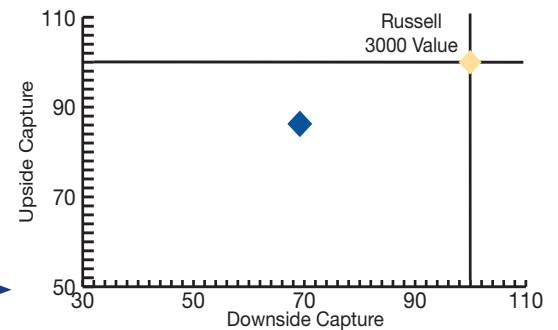

These stock indexes assume reinvestment of dividends and capital gains, and assume no management, custody, transaction or other expenses. Russell statistics used in this presentation were obtained from Russell Investments (www.russell.com). Equity Income performance represents all discretionary commission accounts.

Performance presents results with all dividends and interest income reinvested and is stated in U.S. Dollar terms. Leverage is not used in any portfolio in these composites.
